### **Buses**

All the following buses cross Waterloo Bridge:

1, 4, 26, 59, 68, 76, 139, 168, 171, 172, 176, 188, 243, 341, 521, X68, Riverside Bus (RV1 – which also stops on Upper Ground which runs by the back of the National Theatre).

77 (Upper Ground near the Festival Hall), 211 & 507 (Waterloo Road near the main station), 381 (Stamford Street).

45, 63 & 100 all stop at the southern end of Blackfriars Bridge, and there is a 10 minute walk along the riverside to the National.

### **Rail**

Waterloo, Waterloo East and Charing Cross (across the river via the Hungerford Bridge) are all a 10-15 minute walk from the National.

### **Underground**

The closest tube stations are **Waterloo** (on the Northern, Bakerloo & Jubilee lines), **Southwark** (on the Jubilee line) or walk over the Hungerford Bridge from **Embankment** (on the Northern, Bakerloo, District and Circle lines).
